

BLA COVID Guidance

BLA will follow El Paso County Guidelines.

Everything is subject to change.

- We will continue with regular hand washing and cleaning of classrooms.
- Anyone entering the building is recommended to wear a mask, but not required. All masks are welcome.
- 3ft distance is encouraged in the building, but not required. Close contact is considered 3ft for 15+ minutes.
- PLEASE STAY HOME WHEN YOU ARE SICK. See D49's Illness Guidelines for more information.

- If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, they need to quarantine for 10 days from the symptom-onset or from the test collection date. All positive tests count.
- Quarantines for close contacts (3ft and 15+ minutes) will be utilized as recommended by El Paso County Health guidelines.
- If individual students are required to quarantine, make-up work will be provided by the teacher. We will not be offering hybrid or synchronous learning for quarantined students.
- We will not offer virtual/online learning if the parent/guardian chooses to keep their child home due to close contact and the class itself has not been quarantined. Make-up work will be provided.
- If a teacher needs to quarantine, a substitute will be provided.
- BLA will offer virtual/online learning only in specific cases where a significant number of students need to quarantine.
- Parents/guardians will be notified if their students have been determined as a close contact.
- We are not offering virtual/online learning options for any students as an alternative to inperson learning for the 21-22 school year.
