Colors: white and light blue.




NOT Dress Code compliant shirts: Not approved Colors, Not Solid, No Collar, & Logos



Appropriate Outerwear:

Sweaters, Sweater Vests, Cardigans, Sweatshirts, Hoodies, And Spirit Wear
Plain & Solid in Color: Navy, Burgundy, Forest Green, Gray, and Black
NO LOGOS unless BLA spirit wear.

School dress code approved shirt must be worn under outerwear.



Pants, Shorts, Capris, Jumpers, & Skirts: Plain and Solid in Color: Khaki, Navy, Black, and approved Plaid. Approved Plaid is pictured below.



NOT Dress Code Compliant Bottoms:

All bottoms must be plain & solid in color.

Sweatpants and leggings are not apart of the dress code.

Leggings can be worn under dresses and skirts.

Legs must be fully covered on days the temperature is below 32 degrees.
