



Banning Lewis Preparatory Academy 2023 - 2024 Open Campus Privilege Agreement and Waiver of Liability

11th and 12th grade - All year while meeting expected criteria; **10th grade** - Beginning of 2nd Semester
Expectations:

- Good Behavior: No discipline referrals.
- Good Attendance: No unexcused absences, fewer than five (5) tardies.
- Good Grades: Minimum graduation requirements must be in the process of being met, and a minimum 2.5 GPA.

Terms and Conditions:

- "Open Campus" is defined as a privilege to leave the campus of Banning Lewis Preparatory Academy (BLPA) **during lunch times only**. Students must only enter and leave through the front doors.
- Be aware that during the student's exercise of the open campus privilege, school administration may not know the destination, whereabouts, and/or activity of the student; however, the student is still bound by the rules and regulations pertaining to personal conduct as outlined in the Student Handbook and will be subject to disciplinary action for violations.
- Students who have a signed parental permission slip on file may have an off campus lunch. It is the student's responsibility:
 - Return to school on time when using this privilege.
 - Excessive tardies on return will result in disciplinary action.

Violations can result in:

- Individual loss of open campus privileges.
- Possible forfeiture of open campus privileges for all students.
- Any combination of above.
- Detention/suspension from school.

Waiver of Liability:

- When the student and parent/guardian sign the Open Campus agreement, they agree to release BLPA from any and all liability for a student's actions during his or her exercise of the open campus privilege. Furthermore, the signed agreement also released BLPA from any and all liability for property damage, personal injury, or loss of life while the student is exercising his or her open campus privilege.
